Jokes...

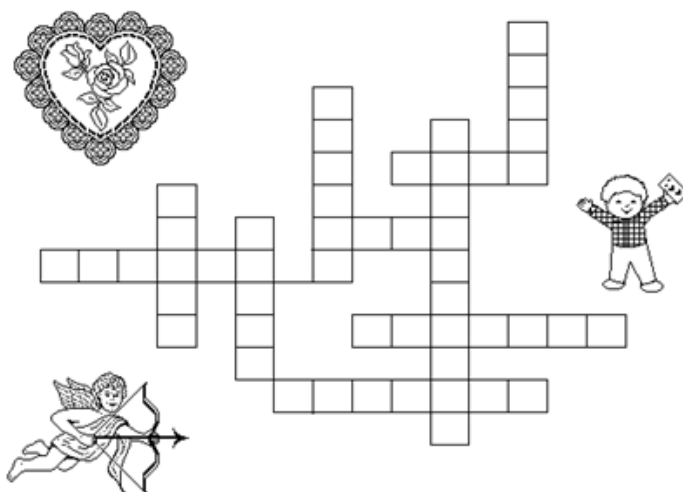
"The Policeman pulled over a car and strolled up to the driver's window: "Excuse me sir, but do you know that you're driving without a rear light?"
